



CROSSINGS NURSERY MINISTRY PREPARE FOR YOUR FIRST VISIT

Crossings Nursery Ministry shares the love of Christ with children and provides the loving care they deserve in a secure environment. We want to make your first visit as smooth as possible, so here's some helpful information for your family to know before you visit!

COVID-19 UPDATE

The safety of your family is paramount to Crossings Community Church, and we're taking precautions to keep your children safe and healthy.

Nursery care is currently available for Sunday morning worship services at 9:30 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. only.

Crossings Nursery ministry has implemented the following safety guidelines:

- Temperatures of staff and children will be taken before entering classrooms.
- Steps are being implemented to reduce touchpoints for families as they check-in and drop off.
- Additional sanitation procedures have been implemented.
- All bottles must be pre-mixed.
- Families are encouraged to have only one parent/guardian for drop off/pick up to help with social distancing.

CHECK IN

Your child's safety is important to us. All children must be checked in by a parent using one of the check-in stations located throughout the building. You'll receive a name tag for your child and a corresponding tag for you. You must show your corresponding tag in order to pick up your child from his/her classroom.

Note: Parents and siblings are asked not to enter the Nursery classrooms. Children are received by staff members at the door, and we will contact you if your child is unable to be comforted.

WHAT TO BRING

When you bring your child to the nursery, please bring the following labeled items in your labeled diaper bag:

- 3-4 diapers
- pre-mixed bottles
- pacifier
- complete change of clothes

ILLNESS

If your child has any of the following symptoms, please do not bring him/her to the Nursery:

- Fever
- Nausea
- Vomiting
- Diarrhea
- Common cold
- Excessive cough
- Childhood diseases
- Chicken pox
- Heavy nasal discharge
- Unexplained rash
- Skin infection
- Eye inflammation or discharge
- Head lice.

Children should be free from these symptoms for at least 24 hours prior to coming to the nursery.

ALLERGIES

Please contact the Crossings Nursery staff if your child has an allergy so it can be indicated on your child's name tag.
