How Then Shall We Live?

- **How then shall we suffer? 1 Peter 4:1-19**
 - Verse 1 - arm yourselves with the same way of thinking
 - Verse 4 - do not join them in the same flood of debauchery
 - Verse 7 - be self-controlled and sober-minded
 - Verse 8 - keep loving one another earnestly
 - Verse 9 - show hospitality to one another without grumbling
 - Verse 10 - use it (your spiritual gifts) to serve one another
 - Verse 12 - do not be surprised at the fiery trial
 - Verse 13 - rejoice insofar as you share Christ's sufferings
 - Verse 15 - let none of you suffer as a murderer or a thief or an evildoer or a meddler
 - Verse 16 - do not be ashamed (of suffering), but let him glorify God
 - Verse 17 - entrust your soul to a faithful Creator while doing good
- **How then shall we lead? 1 Peter 5:1-5**
 - Verse 2 - shepherd the flock
 - Verse 2 - exercise oversight (not under compulsion, not for shameful gain, but eagerly)
 - Verse 3 - do not be domineering over those in your charge
 - Verse 4 - be examples to the flock

- Verse 5 - (when we follow)....be subject to the elders
- Verse 5 - Clothe yourselves, all of you, with humility towards one another

- **How then shall we resist? 1 Peter 5:6-14**
 - Verse 6 - Humble yourselves (under the mighty hand of God)
 - Verse 7 - Cast all your anxieties on him
 - Verse 8 - Be sober-minded
 - Verse 8 - be watchful
 - Verse 9 - Resist him
 - Verse 12 - Stand firm in it (grace of God)
 - Verse 14 - Greet one another with the kiss of love
