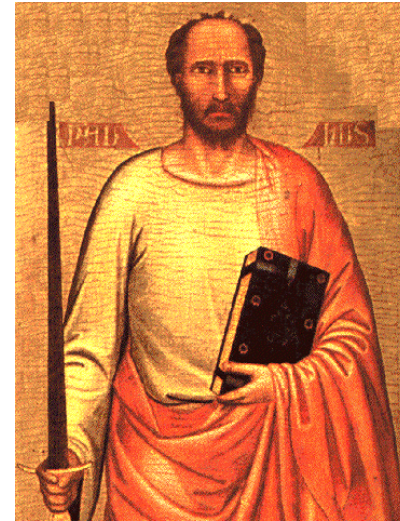
How then can anyone be saved?
