

# MESSAGE DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

JUNE 20, 2021 // EXPERIENCING GOD

Senior Pastor Marty Grubbs continued teaching in our *Unwavering* series where he looked at God’s response to Job. Advice, blame, pity, compassion and more had been offered to Job by his wife and friends, but Job was still in pain and questioning his suffering—its cause and purpose. Job was consumed by his own circumstances. Even if this is understandable, it is limiting, myopic. Job was in desperate need of God-sized perspective and answers, and that’s what he got. God reminded him of who he is and who Job is—and this experience leaves Job forever changed.

## SCRIPTURE – JOB 38-42

### DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. What stood out today from Marty’s message?
2. Read Job 38 and 39. How does God give Job perspective? (Give some specific examples from the Scripture.)
3. Read Job 40:1-7. What is God’s charge, and how does Job reply?
4. Read Job 42:1-6. What has changed in Job?
5. What circumstances or events can narrow people’s perspective? How has this played out in your life?
6. How does a right-sized understanding of God help with perspective? How has experiencing God changed your understanding of him? of yourself?
7. How can we pray for you?

### PRAYER

Ask God for his perspective in your circumstances. Pray to experience him in ways that elevate him and his glory over struggles that can consume you. Remember, God doesn’t negate your struggle or deny its effects, he is a God of compassion and mercy. Pray to God with faith that matches his awesomeness, believing all that he proclaims about himself in Job 38-41.
